Dear Parents, Carers and Pupils

Re: GCSE Examination season 2022

As you are aware, the examination season for Year 11 pupils begins on **Monday 16 May**.

I would be grateful if you would go through the following guidelines with your child during the Easter holiday. They will also be outlined to pupils in school.

EXAMINATIONS ARE SCHEDULED TO START AT 9.30 am and 1.30pm, but pupils must adhere to the usual timing of the school day and attend registration with their tutor at 8.45 am.

Prior to each examination, pupils will attend a 10/15 minute “booster” session. This session is led by the Curriculum Leader and will outline key reminders about the paper. Pupils will then be escorted to the exam venue.

- For morning exams, pupils will register with their tutor and should then go to their pre-exam booster session at 9am.
- Pupil attendance will be pre-entered in the afternoon and pupils should go to their pre-exam booster session at the end of lunchtime at 1.05pm.
- Intervention sessions for Year 11 will end on Thursday 12 May. Session 6 will continue to run until a subject has completed the relevant examinations.

When subject examinations have been completed, pupils will undertake private revision during their timetabled lessons.

Pupils are expected to come prepared with the necessary revision materials and will not be allowed to interrupt other lessons to collect resources.

- Following the Science examination on **Wednesday 15 June**, pupils need only be in school for booster sessions, examinations or revision sessions. **Pupils who have a DT exam in the afternoon of Wednesday 15 June should attend lesson 3 as normal and undertake private revision.**
- Although it is anticipated that most pupils will revise off site from Thursday 16 June, The LRC will be available for private study.
- A number of in school revision sessions are scheduled towards the end of the examination season. All pupils will receive a timetable of booster and revision sessions next term.
